

1950's Era Western Union Clock

- Description (provided by seller):

The following pictures describe a charming 1950s era self winding 80 beat Western Union office clock in very good **original** condition. It features fully functional seconds synchronization. The clock is fully working and has never been tampered with. The dial has never been touched up or repainted.

The clock is missing a brass insert ring for one of the door key holes. It is otherwise 100% complete. The Model 1900GS Kit is optional but very highly recommended. The customer will offer it with the clock for \$119 additional which is an 18% discount from the catalog price.

- History (provided by seller):

“During the 1960's I worked as an outside technician for Western Union in upstate New York. Part of our duties included maintaining these self winding clocks in Western Union offices and at customer sites. In the mid 1960's we started removing them from service and discarding them (sadly). The service provided by Western Union was eventually discontinued. This clock was a Western Union office clock which I have kept running through four moves. It continues to keep very accurate time. With the Model 1900GS Kit, it is accurate to within a few seconds per month. It is a very accurate timepiece.”
